



Build a Fire Extinguisher

Create a pretend fire extinguisher using craft supplies you have at home or classroom. This simple activity builds fine motor skills and reinforces fire safety vocabulary during dramatic play.

Recommended Supplies:

- Empty toilet paper roll
- Red construction paper, red paint, or tempera paint stick (like Kwik Stix)
- Black pipe cleaner, yarn, or paper strip (for hose)
- Small circle of black or gray paper (for nozzle)
- Marker or printable label that says "Fire Extinguisher"
- Tape or glue
- *Optional:* stickers, buttons, or paper shapes to decorate

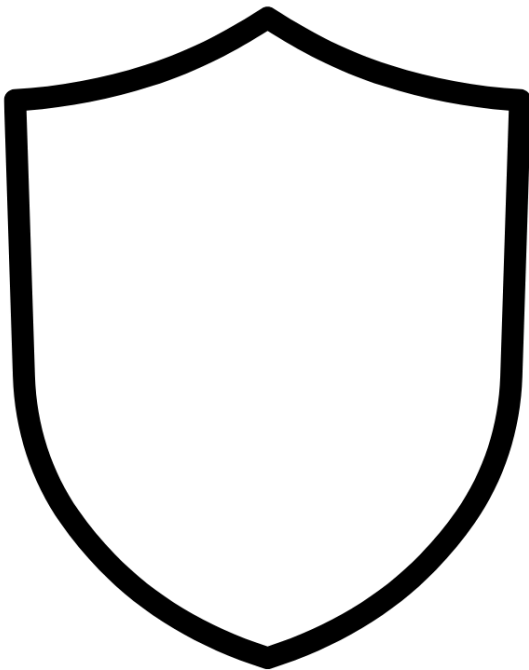
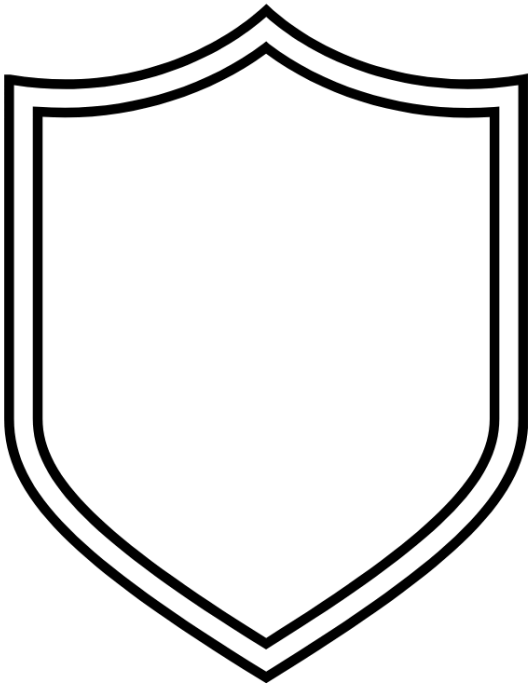
How To Make:

1. Wrap the toilet paper roll with red paper OR paint it red.
2. Attach the hose (pipe cleaner or paper strip) to one side.
3. Curl the end slightly and add the nozzle piece.
4. Add a label with "Fire Extinguisher" written on it.
5. Decorate as desired and use in pretend fire drills or roleplay!

 **Fire Safety Tip:** While making this craft, talk with your kids about when and how real fire extinguishers are used. Emphasize that only adults should use real fire extinguishers in emergencies!

Create Your Own Fire Safety Badge

Design, decorate, and cut out your badge to show off your fire safety skills!



Basic Shapes Fire Truck

Supplies:

- Red construction paper
- White construction paper
- Black construction paper
- Yellow construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black marker

Instructions:

1. Cut the shapes:

- From red paper, cut one square and one long rectangle.
- From white paper, cut one small square (for the window) and one rectangle (for the ladder).
- From black paper, cut three circles for the wheels.
- From yellow paper, cut a trapezoid for the siren.

2. Draw the ladder:

- Use a black marker to draw vertical lines on the white rectangle, making it look like a ladder.

3. Assemble your fire truck:

- Glue the red square to the left side of the red rectangle to form the truck body.
- Glue the white square onto the red square to make the driver's window.

- Glue the ladder (white rectangle) onto the right side of the red rectangle.
- Glue the three black circles along the bottom edge for the wheels.
- Finally, glue the yellow trapezoid on top of the red square.
